Sir,

Without prejudice to the powers of this Board under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act-1974, the Air Act-1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act-1986 and without reducing your responsibilities under the said Acts in any way, this is to inform you that this Board grants Consent to Establish (NOC) for manufacturing of following items at **Rumoma Industries Pvt Ltd, Plot No. 13, 14, A-One Estate, Kewal Kanta Cross Road, Nagarwel Hanuman Road, Rakhial, Ahmedabad - 380023.**

The validity period of the Order will be up to **05/02/2026** from the date of issue.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING SPECIFIC CONDITION :-

1. Unit shall manufacture virgin or recycled carry bags, sheet or rolls having thickness more than 50 microns only.
2. You shall provide labelling or marking on each plastic carry bag containing name and registration number of the manufacturer and thickness of the bag. In case of recycled carry bag, each recycled carry bag shall bear a label or a mark "recycled" and shall conform to the Indian Standard: IS 14534: 1998 as amended from time to time.
3. You shall provide an action plan for collection of plastic waste generated due to your product as per the provision of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.
4. You shall maintain a record of details of person supplying raw material to manufacture plastic rolls & bags.
5. Unit shall comply PWM Rules – 2016.

CONDITIONS UNDER THE WATER ACT:

1. Industrial water consumption shall not exceed **0.2 KLPD** and which shall be used for cooling purpose & reuse, so there shall be no discharge of any kind of industrial effluent from the manufacturing process and other ancillary operations.
2. Domestic water consumption shall not exceed **1.0 KLPD** and the quantity of the domestic waste water (sewage) shall not exceed **0.5 KLPD**. Sewage shall be disposed of through AMC drainage system.

CONDITIONS UNDER THE AIR ACT:

3. There shall be no use of any fuel & no flue gas/process gas emission from the manufacturing process as well as other ancillary industrial operation.
4. Ambient air quality within the premises of the industry shall conform to the following standards:-

5. The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75dB(A) during day time and 70 dB(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6a.m. and 10 p.m. and nighttime is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
6. The applicant shall provide proper ventilation and exhaust facilities so as to maintain healthy working atmosphere within the factory premises.
7. All measures for the control of environmental pollution shall be provided before commencing production.

CONDITIONS UNDER HAZARDOUS WASTE RULES:

8. The applicant shall have to comply with provisions of The Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 framed under EPA Act - 1986.
9. The applicant shall obtain membership of common TSDF site for disposal of Haz. Waste as categorized in the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
10. The applicant shall provide temporary storage facilities for each type of Haz. Waste as per Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
11. The applicant shall have to comply with the provisions of E-Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011.

GENERAL CONDITION:

12. Any change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the consents form/order should immediately be intimated to this Board.



13. The waste generator shall be totally responsible for (i.e. Collection, storage, transportation and ultimate disposal) of the wastes generated.
14. Records of waste generation, its management and annual return shall be submitted to Gujarat Pollution Control Board in Form – 4 by 31 st January of every year.
15. In case of any accident, details of the same shall be submitted in Form – 14 to Gujarat Pollution Control Board.
16. As per "Public liability Insurance Act – 91" company shall get Insurance policy, if applicable.
17. Empty drums and containers of toxic and hazards material shall be treated as per guideline published for "management & handling of discarded containers". Records of the same shall be maintained and forwarded to Gujarat Pollution Control Board regularly.
18. In no case any kind of hazardous waste shall be imported without prior approval of appropriate authority.
19. In case of transport of hazardous waste to a facility for (i.e. Treatment, Storage and disposal) existing in a state other than the state where hazardous waste are generated, the occupier shall obtain "No Objection certificate" from the state pollution Control Board, the Committee of the concerned state or Union territory Administration where the facility exists.
20. Unit shall take all concrete measures to show tangible results in waste generation reduction, avoidance, reuse and recycle. Action taken in this regards shall be submitted within three months and also along with Form – 4.
21. Industry shall have to display the relevant information with regard to hazardous waste as indicated in the Hon Supreme Court's order in W.P. No.657 of 1995 dated 14th October 2003.
22. Industry shall have to display on-line data outside the main factory gate with regard to quantity and nature of hazardous chemicals being handled in the plant, including wastewater and air emissions and solid hazardous waste generated within the factory premises.
