CTR to set up transformer radiator plant at Chikalathana

Aurangabad, Sept 28: The CTR Manufacturing Industries Ltd is presently busy in executing a big expansion plan investing Rs 13 crore in two installations and giving job opportunity to 400 people in a phased manner. This will enable Aurangabad to boast of having the best transformer radiator plant in Asia.

According to sources as a step in the direction of expansion plan, the Chikalathana industrial estate based factory has purchased two adjacent plants. Now the company has total land of 20 acres. The CTR will execute its plan in two phases. In the first phase, the company will manufacture pressed steel radiators with the annual production capacity of 5 lakh meters. In the first phase it will require investment of Rs 13 crore. It will be in operation from January next. The transformer radiators manufactured from here will be exported as well as sold in the domestic market.

When contacted the managing director of the CTR, Manu-cturing Industries Ltd, Anil Kumar, said that availability of steel, power, trained manpower, conducive work culture and good communication facilities are in ample quantities in Aurangabad. Keeping this strength of infrastructure he chose Aurangabad location for expansion.

Talking about the second part of expansion plan, Anil Kumar said his company is one of the largest fine production system manufacturing companies. At present the Chikalathana plant produces 750 pieces in a year. After expansion this capacity will go up to 2000 pieces per year. Rs 7.5 crore will be invested and it will give job to around 100 people. CTR has signed a memorandum of understanding with an Austrian company, VA Tech. This plant will be operational from the mid of 2009. The public relations officer of the company, Sudhir Kortikar, was also present on the occasion.

CTR is engaged in the manufacturing of power instruments from 1947 when Pratap Kumar founded the National Electrical India at Lalbagh in Kolan. Its Pune plant is operational from 1965. The CTR Chikalathana unit is operational from 1976. At on today 200 people are working in this plant.
